Philanthropy Dinner Speaker Announced Curt Simic, Indiana University Foundation

MORGAN COUNTY, Ind. – This week, the Community Foundation of Morgan County announced Curt Simic, President Emeritus of the Indiana University Foundation, will be speaking at the 2nd Annual Philanthropy Awards Dinner. The dinner will be held at the Art Sanctuary of Indiana in Martinsville at 6 p.m. on Thursday, November 5.

Simic, a 1964 graduate of Indiana University Bloomington, has had one of the most distinguished careers in the history of American higher education philanthropy. The winner of several top awards from national organizations, he served for 20 record-breaking years as I.U. Foundation president, following leadership roles at five distinguished universities, including Yale, Oregon, and the University of California Berkeley. Over the decades, he has worked tirelessly, giving of his time and talents to countless institutions and organizations. He has won numerous accolades from his alma mater, including the Distinguished Alumni Service Award, the University Medal – and from the State, the Sagamore of the Wabash. He also won the Lifetime Achievement Award from the National Council for Advancement and Support of Education (CASE).
